Notes:

1. The 1860 and 1870 census mortality schedules asked different questions.
2. The 1860 schedules did not link those who died to families enumerated thus making it impossible to identify unnamed infants.
3. A few medical terms:

Bold Hives = Croup

Dropsy = fluid retention often due to heart failure or kidney disease

Dyspepsia = indigestion & heartburn, heart attack symptoms

Erysipelas = contagious skin disease

Fistula = connection between structures not normally connected

Flux = excessive flow or discharge of fluid

Palsy = paralysis, often meant stroke
